

6pm* Pot Luck

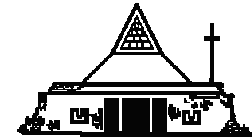
